

2008 MOPAR Builders' Competition Information

Who May Enter?

Any restoration shop that is an established business.

Types of vehicles that may enter

Chrysler, Plymouth, Dodge, AMC between the years of 1963 and 1974. All must be restored to stock/original condition.

Rules, Regulations, and Procedures

- The judging team will be working under the ICCA judging system with Dave Wise acting as head judge. International Chrysler Collector Authority's level #3, The Stock/Restored to Stock, score sheet will be used. Judging will include an evaluation of originality, a function check, and a chassis evaluation for a total of 300 plus points. The exact number of points will be determined and will be circulated to the official shop representative after registration has been accepted.
- The same team of judges will review each vehicle and score each vehicle.
- A judging schedule will be provided to each official representative twenty (20) days prior to the competition date.
- Results will be announced Sunday morning by 10:00 a.m. The winner will be presented with the trophy at the awards ceremony held that day.
- Each vehicle will be displayed under the official MOPAR Builders' Competition Tent.
- Each registered shop may display one banner. No other signage, sign boards, or company literature may be displayed. It is the responsibility of the restoration shop to have the banner produced in the size specified by Chrysler Classic Events. This banner may be hung in tent at an assigned area.
- All vehicles must be registered under the name of the restoration shop.
- Vehicle must be fully functional and 100% complete at time of competition.
- All documents and information requested must be submitted for acceptance.
- Once a vehicle is submitted and accepted, that vehicle must compete. No substitutions will be permitted, and no refunds will be given for withdrawal.
- Each restoration shop may submit a maximum of two vehicles for consideration. We reserve the right to decline acceptance of any vehicle for any reason.
- A maximum of ten (10) vehicles will be accepted for the competition.
- Vehicle must be available to be displayed at the Norwalk show starting Friday, September 12th at 10:00 a.m. and remain on display until Sunday, September 14th at 2:00 p.m. A representative from the restoration shop must be on site and available to answer questions and handle the vehicle during judging.
- By registering for the competition, the restoration shop and vehicle owners are agreeing to allow Chrysler Classic Events, Mopar Collectors Guide Magazine, and ICCA to announce and promote their participation.
- Builder of the Year award winner will receive a company profile in Mopar Collectors Guide Magazine. An interview and photo shoot will be conducted no later than one month after the winner is announced. MCG Magazine will choose the issue in which the company profile will appear.

What needs to be submitted for competition consideration and acceptance

- 2008 MOPAR Builders' Competition official entry form
- Registration fee of \$300. If vehicle is NOT accepted into the competition, the full registration fee will be returned.
- Three photos of the vehicle being entered. These photos should be a full body shot, an interior shot, and an under the hood shot. NOTE: If the vehicle is not completed at time of registration, one photo showing the current stage of the restoration process should be submitted.

Once accepted into the competition, the following items must be submitted sixty (60) days prior to the competition.

- ICCA Owners Disclosure form
- Vehicle history including ownership trail, tracing of VIN number, copies of any articles covering the vehicle, and copies if available of the build sheet, original fender tag, and the original window sticker.
- Brief bio on the restoration shop including ownership, date established, location, number of employees, web site address, business address, and business phone.
- Completed release form granting permission to Chrysler Classic, ICCA, and Mopar Collectors Guide Magazine to use information, including photos and documentation. Release form will be provided.
